Electronic Entries

The organisers of this meet prefer clubs/organisations to enter using the electronic entry files provided, those submitting entries via the paper based entry form will pay 50p extra per entry.

The first stage is to download Sportsystems Entry Manager by simply clicking on this link <http://www.swimmingresults.org/customerservices/downloads/SS/SS20EntryManagerInstall.exe>

This installs the Entry Manager programme on your computer, once installed there is no requirement to re install when completing entries for future meets, however please always check the updates function to ensure you are running the latest version of the software as there may be new features which older versions of entry manager will not support, an example of this is the qualifying times checking function.

The entry file has been set to import entry times from British Rankings about 12 months prior to the closing date i.e. 1st March 2009, additionally any short course times will also be checked and automatically converted to long course, if they are faster, those times will populate the entries fields.

Times which are outside of the consideration time will be flagged yellow.

You can use the reports feature to calculate the total cost of your entries.

This new system was designed to streamline the job of entries secretaries and ensure mistakes are kept to a minimum, any errors in misspelt names or inaccurate dates of birth should be eliminated and the whole process should be speeded up.
